 From its beginnings in 1856 as a seminary for women to its status today as an innovative, coeducational liberal arts college, Lake Erie College has always promoted the philosophy that intercultural understanding, a sense of social responsibility and the ability to solve problems creatively are the cornerstones of a comprehensive education.

Today, Lake Erie College offers courses and schedules to accommodate traditional and adult students, with 22 undergraduate majors and two graduate degree programs. The College has an enrollment of 977* students from 28 states and eight foreign countries, 228 of whom live on campus. Lake Erie students have the opportunity to experience foreign cultures and languages firsthand through short "Passport to the Future" courses or by  studying abroad for a full semester.
