- 625 students come from 42 states and 15 countries
- 52% female; 48% male
- Student faculty ratio: 10 to 1.
- Average class size: 15 to 20.
- 640-acre campus surrounds a 70-acre lake.
- 89% of faculty hold a doctorate or other terminal degree.
- 95% of the graduates are either employed or enrolled in graduate school within 6 months of graduation.
- Nationally-recognized General Education Program (SAGE).
- Nearly half of St. Andrews students study overseas.
- Honors Program for top students.
- 90% of students live on campus in 8 residence halls organized in suites of 6 or 7 rooms, wired for internet use. One residence hall has 24-hour attendant care for students with physical disabilities.

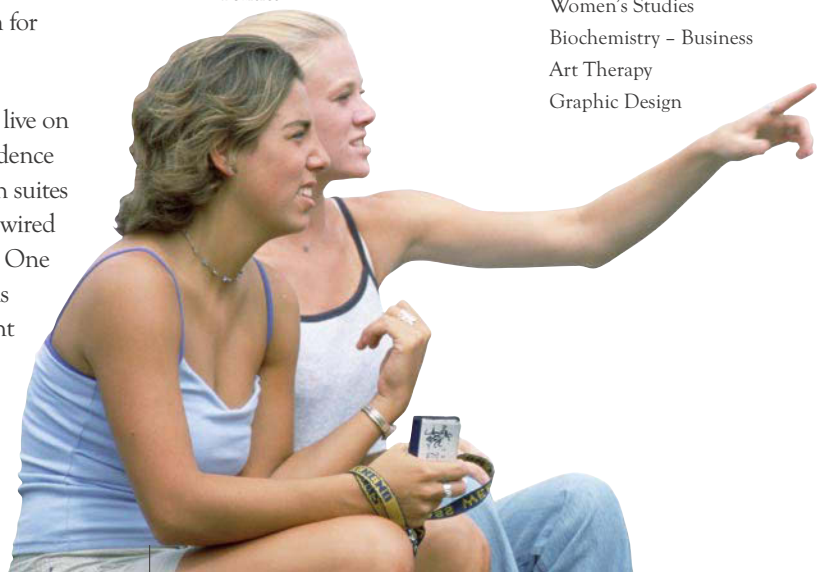

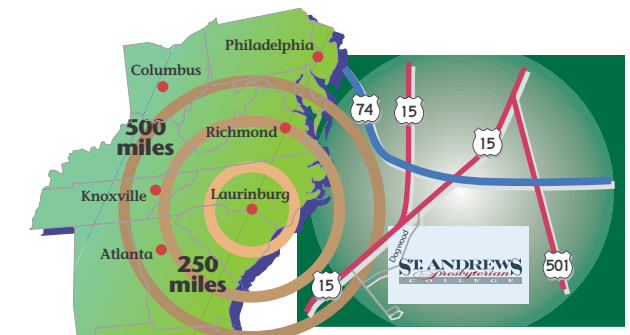
